### WHAT WILL YOU GET?

A delicious, cooked breakfast, a full color quilt pattern, a quilt demonstration, & 10% off any fabric purchase that day. You will also get a recipe each month, which is the same as the name of the quilt pattern!

### HOW WILL THIS WORK?

We will meet each month for breakfast first, because after all, who can work on an empty stomach? And I promise, this will be a very high fiber diet! After breakfast, I will distribute the patterns and demonstrate how to make one block from that month's pattern. (Each monthly pattern consists of only one block design repeated as many times as necessary to make the size quilt you desire). If you decide it is a pattern that you like, you can then purchase the fabrics to make whatever size project you want at a 10% discount price. The pattern will include the fabric requirements and directions for 4 place mats, a table runner, a lap, twin, full, queen or king size quilt. You purchase what you choose, or use some of your stash. All patterns are made with 2 1/2" strips, so these patterns are perfect for jelly rolls. The last day of the month is the final deadline to sign up for the following month's meeting.

International Mystery Quilt is a new monthly series of hands-on classes that will meet on a select Saturday each month. There is no sample made in advance because the final quilt is a "mystery!" You will bring your machine and sew in class, therefore we will have to limit the enrollment each month. We will have a little teaser about the class on our bulletin board near the cash register, and you will be able to select from three color ways, each of which are named for the particular country of the month. The fabric swatches will be on the bulletin board. You must obtain your passport (registration) by a particular date so that we can cut the proper number of kits of each chosen color way. As soon as registration ends for one month, we will post information for the next month's mystery. Join in the fun-this is so exciting!

Please bring a bag lunch, as we will take a lunch break around noon.

## ICE CREAM CONE QUILT

from Quilt In A Day  
Thur, April 30, May 7 & 14    5-8pm  
Cost: \$45 + materials  
Teacher: Debi Gilpin

This quilt looks good enough to eat! It has 9 blocks with appliquéd ice cream cones in the middle of each. Included in the class fee is a small square of each of the 9 colors of Fairy Frost for the ice cream portion of the block. The appliqués are created using fusible interfacing, which is an interesting and easy technique for doing appliqué with no raw edges exposed. We do sell preprinted fusible for the projects in this book, which you may purchase, or you can use regular fusible, but you will have to trace carefully the cones and ice cream. We will stuff the ice cream portion with some batting to make it 3 dimensional. This is a great class for those wanting to learn to appliqué. It is also great for those who may have appliquéd using the conventional technique. This is so much easier! Book is required.

## WATER LILY PIN CUSHION

This water lily pincushion is a wonderful way to use those 5" nickel squares of fabric. Depending on your choice of coordinating colors, it can be a beautiful flower to hold your pins or an interesting home décor item. It changes "personality" when constructed as a scrappy pin cushion. The size is approximately 5 inches square with a ball-shaped center and three rows of petals glued to a base of cardboard and batting. The petals begin as circles which are folded and hand stitched into units. These make great, inexpensive gifts in less than three hours.

TRAVEL/CRAFT ROLL  
Thursday, June 4, 5-8PM  
Cost: \$25 (includes kit)

Here is another class that is just in time for vacations and traveling. This roll is made of Thimbleberries fabrics and has lots of pockets for curling irons, sunscreen, lotions, and all kinds of items you need to pack. You can also use this as a craft roll and put in paintbrushes or crochet hooks, etc. Many uses for this easy-to-make project. Just roll it up and tie it closed! This is a great beginner project.

TIE POINT RUNNER  
Saturday, June 6, 9AM-2PM  
Cost: \$25 + materials (pattern included)  
Teacher: Karen Schoener

Here is another one of those difficult-to-describe projects. Welllll-- it is a table runner that is made of strips that are sewn right sides together into a point. Then we turn them right side out and sew the strips together with the points facing outward at staggered intervals. Because we sewed the strips right sides together first, both sides of this reversible runner are completed in one step. See, I told you this is hard to describe! If you can't envision this from my description, don't feel bad-I probably couldn't either! You'll just have to come and see!

PIEDMONT SHIRT

This is a garment class that uses a pattern by Brensan Studios. It is made of 4 coordinating fabrics that are cut

according to the pattern to look like a patchwork shirt. I made one of these from Through the Seasons fabric last year, and many of you requested this as a class. You will need to purchase the pattern and should have some sewing experience for this class.

CUPCAKE PLACEMATS

These are absolutely the cutest thing you have ever seen! They are cupcake shaped placemats that are perfect for that special birthday dinner. They will certainly make for a festive table. We begin with a preprinted panel (what could be easier?) and add borders and triangles to make a beautiful accessory for your holiday home.

ISN'T CHRISTMAS JOLLY QUILT

SCALLOPED TABLE TOPPER

This table topper measures approximately 24" in diameter and is made of 4 fat quarters in coordinating Christmas prints. Use it in the center of your holiday table to highlight a pretty candle or fruit bowl. The edges are scalloped and you can add lace or piping if you desire. This is a very pretty item.

DINNER PARTY TABLE RUNNER

Cost: \$30 (includes pattern and panel)  
Teacher: Donna Eicher

This is an easy Moda pattern using a preprinted panel for the center. We have two other patterns that can be made with the remaining pieces of the panel. The colors in this project are a very contemporary kiwi green, turquoise, and Christmas red. Stop in and see the sample.

PAPER PIECED HEART BABY QUILT

## WATERCOLOR MINI QUILT

This is a brand new class here at Sew Special. This technique uses 2" squares of fabrics in varying shades of lights and darks to make a "watercolor" effect. We will provide the fabrics because you need small amounts of so many different shades. We will also use a fusible 2" grid interfacing to make the process even simpler. If we have a good response, we will include a larger project with this technique next time.

## AUTUMN STAINED GLASS

### WALLHANGING

Saturday, September 5, 9AM-4PM

Cost: \$40 (includes pattern)

Teacher: Donna Eicher

It has been a while since we have done a stained glass project. This technique features appliqué where the raw edges are covered with fusible bias tape in your choice of color to give the appearance of "stained glass". Stitch the bias down with a twin needle or a zig-zag stitch and you will be surprised how beautiful your project becomes!

## OVEN MITT PROJECT

Thursday, September 10, 5-8PM

Cost: \$15 + materials

Teacher: Beth Vilsack

Join us as we make a unique pair of oven mitts that make a wonderful hostess gift or a useful decorative item for your kitchen. Make them in fabrics to match your décor.

## STUFFED COTTON PUMPKINS

We are partnering with a non-profit agency to make this possible both for the girls and for a tax deduction for you. Please see me if you are interested. This is a great way to make a positive difference in a girl's life!
